The Layout

The Gulf & Denver Railroad is a freelance standard gauge HO-scale railroad of the Cowtown Model Railroad Club. The layout is the reincarnation of the former Lockheed

Model Railroad Club (LMRA RR) layout in a room that is approximately 50' x 30'. The layout runs along the walls. There is a center section with backdrop dividing the sides and a large dog-bone section coming off the center peninsula. The layout structure wise is set in the transition era but clearances have been set for modern height cars.

The layout design is walk around using the Easy DCC (Digital Command and Control). The track is mostly Atlas code 100 with Peco turnouts powered by Tortoise Switch machines. Track work is 100% complete while the scenery and backdrops are 60% complete. We are operational while still under construction.

Layout Operation

Operating sessions are controlled by RailOp computer-based software which generates freight switch lists and engineer orders.



For members to operate on the layout, they are required to have a smooth running, DCC equipped locomotive (diesel or steam) with front and rear Kadee couplers.

Monthly Newsletter

Each month the CMRRC publishes an electronic newsletter for its members. The newsletter provides the latest news on

current and future activities and events as well as articles on various railroad topics, tips on construction and interests.

North Texas Council of Railroad Clubs

The CMRRC (former LMRA RR Club) is a charter member of the North Texas Council of Railroad Clubs (NTCRC), an organization of some 30 railroad clubs,

societies, and historical organizations that together promote model railroading in the Fort Worth-Dallas area by sponsoring two train shows a year. The fall show is usually in late September/early October and the winter show in January. Both shows are held in the Plano Convention Center.
